The oils are mixed with the orris-root, the other ingredients are added, then all are mixed to a stiff paste with alcohol. You may divide the mass into tablets or suitable size.

HOW TO FRESHEN A ROOM.

If one of your trials is the stale smell of tobacco, put into a wide-mouthed jar a lump of salts of ammonia and a little spirits of lavender. Leave the jar uncovered.

MASSAGE FOR A WRINKLED FOREHEAD.

Seated before your mirror place the first and second fingers with firm pressure horizontally on the forehead. Now separate the fingers and make tiny circles with the finger-tip of the index finger of the other hand, rubbing at right angles to the wrinkle. For the scowling, perpendicular wrinkles reverse the position of the fingers so that you may always smassage cross-wise to the wrinkles.

TO STIMULATE GROWTH OF EYEBROWS..

There is nothing better for this purpose, I believe, than the application of pure olive oil. Use a tiny brush, training the brows as you wish them to grow.

TO PREVENT DISCOLORATION OF BRUISES.

Immediately apply to the injured spot a cloth wrung out of hot water. As soon as the cloth begins to cool replace it with a hot one.

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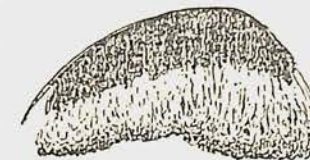
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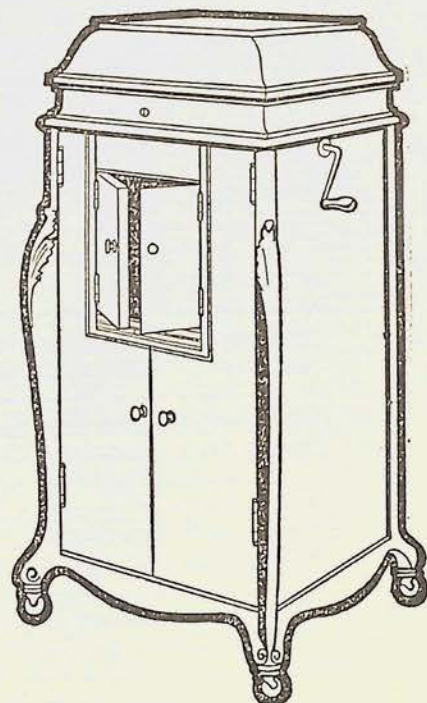


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
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Fashions for Women

MODES IN BRIEF.

Flowers of small varieties, such as forget-me-nots, lilacs and violets, are combined with tulle to form cabochons at the fastenings of a bodice or skirt.

Any amount of beadwork and alluring embroidery effects are used as garniture.

Many of the brightly colored new foulards are veiled with smoke-colored mousseline de soie.

Still the favorite costume for afternoon wear is of taffeta, foulard or satin in dark navy blue.

Ecrú mousseline de soie has superseded white for separate collars and cuffs.

TURN MATTRESS.

A mattress should be turned every day, but unless the turning is done carefully it is liable to work the stuffing out of shape.

To prevent this, sew handles of ticking or webbing to the sides, and you will be able to turn the mattress without straining the ticking.

When one of the rosettes shows signs of coming off, it should be immediately stitched in position, or the stuffing will rapidly work out of place and the mattress will lose its shape.

New rosettes may be made out of old kid gloves and sewn on with fine twine with a long upholstery needle.

DETAILS TELL.

It is difficult for the modern purse in these times of high prices to keep up with the latest fashions. However, if such details as neckwear, sleeves, hats and gowns, correct length in coats and skirts are strictly in fashion, a woman will appear up-to-date on a fairly small allowance.

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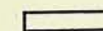
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Men's Corner

OVERCOATS.

Now that the winter season has set in the heavy overcoat is very much in evidence, and, although the weather is not very severe as yet, many fur-lined coats are being worn, and from all indications fur-lined coats with mink and black lamb collars are going to be very popular. The heavy Irish Frieze Ulster and Scotch Tweed Overcoats will carry a belt in the back to make them look stylish, and the Lord Raglan Sleeve will be much worn again.

HEAD GEAR..

The Rough Cloth or Raggy Fedora Hat will be very much worn this winter for street wear as it is much warmer than the Derby, although the black Derby is selling fast this Xmas tide. Many Persian Lamb Hats are being sold also both in the Wedge and Military style. The Cloth Cap will be very popular for street wear also this winter, especially in Scotch plaids.

NECK SCARFS.

Never before have the long motor scarfs had such a run as this year at the haberdashers. Long motor scarfs of silk are having a tremendous sale, the favorite colors being white and grey. This long scarf is largely replacing the Phoenix muffler, and the old style square neck scarf is not proving a good seller at all this year.

SHOES.

Heavy Tan Shoes without rubbers are still selling well, but rubbers and light black shoes are being called for by most men for every day wear. 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Xmas Recipes

GOVERNOR'S MINCEMEAT.

This recipe was the favorite of the wife of one of the former governors of Massachusetts. As the amounts of spice seem excessive, I will simply change to season to taste, which is always the safer plan in nearly all recipes.

Because of using best rump steak and other general points of makeup, especially for the excess of spice originally called for, it seems more expensive than necessary. Cheaper meat could be used to about as good advantage in relish.

Four and one-half pounds best rump steak, 4½ pounds of apple chopped fine, ¾ pounds chopped suet, cinnamon, ground cloves, 7 cups sugar, 3 rounding tablespoons salt, grated nutmeg, 3 pounds raisins.

The meat will boil down to about two pounds, which must be finely chopped or ground. The raisins are to be cooked in water and seeded. Mix all the ingredients well and moisten with the meat liquor reduced, 1 cup raisin liquor and ½ cup or more sweet pickle juice.

Reserve a few of the raisins to lay around on top of the pies with small bits of butter before putting on the top crust. Many add citron, currants and other fruits as well as flavors, but the above has been highly recommended by one who should know. Boiled sweet cider was formerly considered almost indispensable, but if used it should be positively sweet, or simple apple juice as freshly pressed from the apples.

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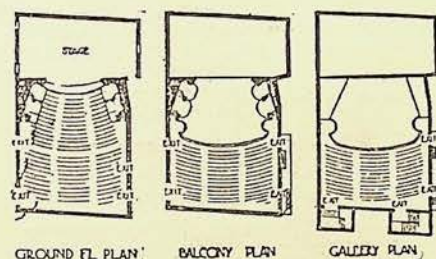
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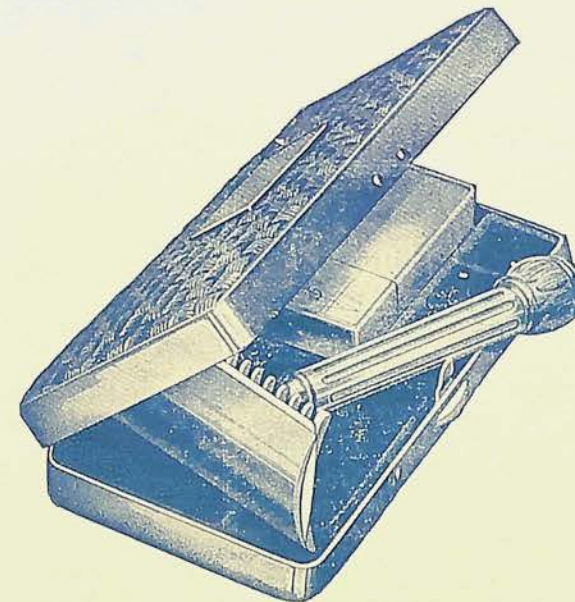
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
